Program Overview

Graduates of the Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) program may find careers in family counselling, mental health and addictions, child welfare, healthcare, criminal justice, community development, activism, and advocacy.

Full- and part-time studies available.

Applicants must be proficient in the English language.

Pre-Social Work (Year 1)

Students must complete 30 credit units of required and elective courses with a minimum average of 70%.

Bachelor of Social Work (Years 2 - 4)

Upon completion of the Pre-Social Work program, students will be eligible to apply to the Faculty of Social Work. Admission to the Faculty is competitive across the province; seats are limited.

Students must complete two practicums. Whenever possible, students are placed within their home community.

*Criminal Record or Vulnerable Sector Checks may be required for practicum placements.

Entrance Requirements

- Grade 12 diploma with:
 - one approved math or science
 - one approved 30-level language, social science, or fine arts
 - one additional approved 30-level course
 - overall average of 70% in core subjects

Estimated Cost

Tuition: \$7,000/year Books/Fees: \$1,200/year

Application Procedure

1. Gather required documents:

- application form
- copy of all transcripts
 - *If currently enrolled in high school, you must submit a Statement of Grades form.*

3. Your application will be assessed by a student advisor to determine admissibility.

4. You will be sent a letter regarding admissibility and, if appropriate, how to apply to the accrediting institution.

5. You must submit a copy of your admission letter from the accrediting institution to secure your seat at Northlands College.

Selection is based on successful admission to the appropriate accrediting institution.
