Program Overview

Graduates of Bachelor of Science in Nursing enjoy careers in community/public health agencies, clinics, hospitals, long-term care facilities, psychiatric offices, rehabilitation services, schools, and seniors' homes and facilities.

Full- and part-time studies available.

Applicants must be proficient in the English language.

Pre-professional (Year 1)

Students must complete 30 credit units of required and elective courses with a minimum average of 60%.

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Years 2 - 4)

Upon completion of year 1, students will be eligible to apply to the College of Nursing. Admission to the College of Nursing is competitive based on Year 1 standings; seats are limited.

Students must complete clinicals in Years 2 - 4. Travel outside of home community may be necessary.

*Criminal Record or Vulnerable Sector Checks may be required for clinical placements.

Entrance Requirements (Year 1)

- Grade 12 diploma with:
 - One of: Foundations of Mathematics 30, Pre-Calculus 30, Calculus 30, Math B30 or Math C30*
 - Biology 30*
 - Chemistry 30*
 - Overall average of 70% in core subjects

*Admission with a deficiency may be possible; please consult a student advisor.

Estimated Cost

Tuition: \$10,000/year Books/Fees: \$1,500/year

Application Procedure

1. Gather required documents:

- application form
- copy of all transcripts
 - *If currently enrolled in high school, you must submit a Statement of Grades form.*

3. Your application will be assessed by a student advisor to determine admissibility.

5. You must submit a copy of your admission letter from the accrediting institution to secure your seat at Northlands College.
