Program Overview

Graduates of the Business Administration program may find careers in accounting, marketing, operations, personnel or general administration.

Full- and part-time studies available.

Applicants must be proficient in the English language.

Qualifying Program (Year 1)

Student must complete 30 credit units of required and elective courses with a minimum average of 65% before applying to the Faculty of Business Administration. Acceptance into the Faculty is not guaranteed.

Diploma (Year 2)

Upon completion of the qualifying program, students will be eligible to apply to the Faculty of Business Administration. Admission to the faculty is competitive across the province; seats are limited.

Graduates of the Business Administration Diploma may be eligible to continue their studies on-campus to pursue a four-year Bachelor of Business Administration Degree.

Entrance Requirements

- Grade 12 diploma with:
 - one of: Foundations of Mathematics 30, Pre-Calculus 30, Calculus 30, or Math B30
 - overall average of 65% in core subjects
- OR a Business Administration Certificate from SaskPoly with an average of 72%

Estimated Cost

Tuition: \$8,000/year Books/Fees: \$1,600/year

Application Procedure

1. Gather required documents:
 - application form
 - copy of all transcripts
 - *If currently enrolled in high school, you must submit a Statement of Grades form.*
