Program Overview

This one-year Continuing Care Assistant certificate program combines hands-on classroom learning with practical clinical experience to prepare students for work in a variety of health care environments.

Graduates may find employment in long-term care, home care, assisted living, acute care, or special needs classrooms assisting clients with mobility, personal care, eating, and medication monitoring.

Applicants must be proficient in the English language and should have personal and physical suitability for work in the health care industry.

Student will participate in three clinical work placements which may involve shift work, travel outside the community, and overnight stays.

Accepted applicants will be required to provide:

- evidence of a Vulnerable Sector Check
- immunization records

Note: A positive result on the VSC may result in the loss of your accepted seat. Students must meet the minimum VSC criteria set out by the practicum agency.

Entrance Requirements

- Grade 12 diploma
OR 15 post-secondary credits from a recognized institution

Application Procedure

1. Gather required documents:

- application form
- copy of all transcripts
 - *If currently enrolled in high school, you must submit a Statement of Grades form.*

5. If accepted, you must fulfill all program readiness components to secure your seat in the program.

First Qualified, First Accepted (FQFA)

To be deemed qualified, an applicant must meet the minimum entrance requirements, complete the application procedures, and successfully complete an intake interview.
