Program Overview

In year one, students in the Environmental Sciences program develop core knowledge and applied skills in biology, chemistry, ecosystems, topography, environmental sustainability, scientific writing and statistics.

For the diploma's second year of study, students choose one of four majors. They can continue with: Northlands College - Air Ronge, SK

- Environmental Conservation & Reclamation

Or transfer to:

Lakeland College - Vermillion, AB

- Water Conservation & Management
- Wildlife & Fisheries Conservation
- Conservation & Restoration Ecology

Graduates of the diploma programs may be eligible to complete two more years of study with partnering institutions to pursue a university degree.

Entrance Requirements

- Grade 12 diploma with:
 - min. 65% in both English Language Arts A30 & B30
 - one of: Chemistry 30, Physical Science 30, or min. 65% in Chemistry 20 or Physical Science 20
 - one of: Biology 30, or min. 65% in Biology 20, Environmental Science 20, or Health Science 20
 - Pre-calculus 30 or min. 60% in Foundations of Mathematics 30

Tuition: \$5,318/year

Books/Fees: \$1,300/year

Application Procedure

1. Gather required documents:

- application form
- copy of all transcripts
 - *If currently enrolled in high school, you must submit a Statement of Grades form.*

To be deemed qualified, an applicant must meet the minimum entrance requirements, complete the application procedures, and successfully complete an intake interview.
