Program Overview

Graduates of the Local Government Authority (LGA) program may find careers in Saskatchewan government and municipal administration.

Full- and part-time studies available.

Applicants must be proficient in the English language.

LGA Certificate

This certificate satisfies the educational requirement for the "Class C," RMAA, and UMASS certification to become a municipal administrator in Saskatchewan. Student complete four core online courses.

LGA Advanced Certificate

Students complete an additional six online or lecture required and elective courses.

Graduates of the Advanced Certificate may be eligible to continue their studies to pursue a Bachelor of Arts degree.

Entrance Requirements

- Grade 12 diploma

Estimated Cost

LGA Certificate

Tuition: \$3,500 Books/Fees: \$600

Advanced LGA Certificate

Tuition: \$8,000 Books/Fees: \$1,200

Application Procedure

1. Gather required documents:

- application form
- copy of all transcripts
 - *If currently enrolled in high school, you must submit a Statement of Grades form.*

3. Your application will be assessed by a student advisor to determine admissibility.
