## Program Overview

Practical Nursing is a two-year diploma program. Onsite labs and community-based clinical experiences let students apply theory and skills in a variety of environments. Through lectures and extensive hands-on learning, students are empowered to become competent, confident nurses capable of bringing a holistic, humanistic approach to patient care.

Applicants must be proficient in the English language and should have personal and physical suitability for work in the health care industry.

Students will participate in clinical work placements involving shift work, travel outside the community, and overnight stays.

Accepted applicants will be required to provide:

- evidence of a Vulnerable Sector Check
- immunization records

*Note: A positive result on the VSC may result in the loss of your accepted seat. Students must meet the minimum VSC criteria set out by the practicum agency.*

## Entrance Requirements

- Grade 12 diploma with a minimum overall average of 65% in:
  - English Language Arts A30 & B30
  - one 30-level mathematics
  - one of: Social Studies 30, History 30, or Native Studies 30
  - one of: Biology 30, Chemistry 30, or Physics 30

## Estimated Cost

Tuition: \$5,461/year      Books/Fees: \$2,100/year

## Application Procedure

1. Gather required documents:

- application form
- copy of all transcripts
  - *If currently enrolled in high school, you must submit a Statement of Grades form.*

Applicants must meet the minimum entrance requirements, complete the application procedures, and undergo an intake interview.

Selections will be made based on academics and interview.
