



Women in Trades – Plumbing & Electrical

Program Overview

This program is designed to prepare women for employment in the industrial trades. Through a combination of in-class and hands-on training, students will gain the entry level skills required for employment in plumbing and electrical.

Applicants must have good eyesight, hearing, manual dexterity, and physical agility. They must also be able to work at heights, work in confined spaces, and lift heavy materials. Possession of a valid class 5 driver's licence is recommended.

Plumbing and Electrical is Phase 2 of 2 for the Women in Trades program. The first phase is Carpentry and is being offered September 3, 2019 to December 20, 2019. Applicants must apply for each phase separately.

Graduates of this program may be eligible for credit towards apprenticeship training and may find employment with construction companies, contractors, or maintenance departments.

To be deemed qualified, an applicant must meet the minimum entrance requirements, complete the application procedures, and successfully complete an intake interview.
