Program Overview

In this program, studies will focus on:

- Indigenous awareness
- addictions and the criminal justice system
- behavioural intervention strategies and therapeutic activities
- communication, employability and problem-solving skill
- crisis prevention/self-protection strategies
- health & wellness, human growth and development
- planning and implementing activities

Graduates of the one-year certificate program are qualified for jobs as youth or family service workers in educational, residential, social services or community-based agencies.

Students will participate in two four-week practicums in which travel may be necessary.

Accepted applicants will be required to provide:

- evidence of a Vulnerable Sector Check

Note: A positive result on the VSC may result in the loss of your accepted seat. Students must meet the minimum VSC criteria set out by the practicum agency.

 - *If currently enrolled in high school, you must submit a Statement of Grades form.*

To be deemed qualified, an applicant must meet the minimum entrance requirements, complete the application procedures, and successfully complete an intake interview.
